

Petition Letter H.R 1101

Dear Representative:

Congressional representatives of both political parties continue to talk in "double speak" on defunding or repealing the 2010 Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act, also called "Obamacare" or "Pelosicare." I really don't care what the Federal takeover of an individual's right to purchase or not purchase health-insurance coverage is called. What I do care about are my constitutional rights, and repealing over-reaching, unconstitutional, and counter-productive Federal laws and regulations. We need to stop the Federal government's takeover of health-insurance decisions now and not later.

This is why I support H.R. 1101, "The End the Mandate Act."
